**Estate:** Founded in 1177 by monks, the Mönchhof (monk's house) was acquired by the Eymael family in 1804 from Napoleon. Today, Robert Eymael leads the estate recognized for its high quality from the entry level Estate Riesling to the finest single vineyard wines.

**Tasting Note:** Ripe white peach aromatics mix with hints of exotic fruit. On the palate there are classic Würzgarten floral spice notes, which swirl with pear, guava, red raspberry, lemon, iris and hints of pineapple. Wine offers excellent volume with a rich texture and a long finish. This Spätlese is sourced from the original part of the Würzgarten (where the vines are between 60-100 years old).

**Food Affinity:** Great to enjoy on its own, but also great with spicy dishes or fusion cuisine.
