Estate: The Haart family has the longest winemaking tradition in the village of Piesport. With over 600 years of history, the Haart's have shown a rare dedication and love for wine. Their estate is located at the foot of the Piesporter Goldtröpfchen vineyard and is planted to 100% Rieslings. In 2007 Theo Haart was named "Wine Maker of the Year" in the German Wine Guide - Gault-Millau.

Tasting Note: The aromatics reveal classic slate and deep earth notes, with hints of white tree fruit. On the palate the wine's structure is impressive, with a juicy acidity and spicy minerality. While dominated by flavors of ripe white / yellow peach and mineral, there are also hints of apricot, red raspberry, and tangy lime. It is a powerful, yet elegant Spätlese.

Food Affinity: This fruity style Riesling is great to enjoy on its own, but works best with spicy dishes or fusion cuisine.
