Estate: Sebastian Prüm (1794-1871) was the patriarch of the original Prüm. Anna and Dr. F. Weins, his granddaughter and son-in-law, started the estate with their inheritance. Original holdings were in the Wehlener Sonnenuhr, Graacher Domprobst and Himmelreich. Additional vineyards came about when their daughter married Mr. Selbach who brought with him holdings in the Ürziger Würzgarten and Erdener Prälat. Mr. Selbach asked his son, Bert, to take charge of the estate in 1978 due to failing health. Today, Bert fashions some of the finest renditions of Wehlener and Graacher Riesling in the valley.

Tasting Note: Slate minerals blend with apple tones in the aromatics. Really fantastic on the palate – such style – tangy citrus, with fine pinpoint slate details. Bright and juicy pear fruit with a stony, elegant terroir. This is a beautifully light “old school” Kabinett. Excellent balance.

Food Affinity: Great to enjoy on its own, but also great with spicy dishes, salads, poultry and cheeses.
