**Estate:** Sebastian Prüm (1794-1871) was the patriarch of the original Prüm. Anna and Dr. F Weins, his granddaughter and son-in-law, started the estate with their inheritance. Original holdings were in the Wehlener Sonnenuhr, Graacher Domprobst and Himmelreich. Additional vineyards came about when their daughter married Mr. Selbach who brought with him holdings in the Ürziger Würzgarten and Erdener Prälät. Mr. Selbach asked his son Bert to take charge of the estate in 1978 due to failing health. Today, Bert fashions some of the finest renditions of Wehlener and Graacher Riesling in the valley.

**Tasting Note:** This is the richest Spätlese right now, yellow peach fruit dominates. On the palate, the wine has the elegance of a Kabinett, but with more focused and prominent slate details. The fruit is also denser, but still wonderfully light, the wine is very precise. The finish offers pineapple, cassis with a hint of red fruit, all tinged with tangy lemon and orange citrus.

**Food Affinity:** Excellent companion to spicy dishes, rich, creamy pastas and fruit based dishes.
