Estate: The Haart family has the longest winemaking tradition in the village of Piesport. With over 600 years of history, the Haart's have shown a rare dedication and love for wine. Their estate is located at the foot of the Piesporter Goldtröpfchen vineyard and is planted to 100% Rieslings. In 2007 Theo Haart was named "Wine Maker of the Year" in the German Wine Guide - Gault-Millau.

Tasting Note: Dusty slate, flint and citrus notes on the nose. On the palate, the wine comes alive with yellow peach, grapefruit and lime; there is definitely more citrus here than in previous vintages of the Ohligsberg. Exotic tropical fruits pop at the mid palate with a concentrated peach core, great length. Lively, balanced and juicy; the acidity has an exciting citrus tang.

Food Affinity: Great to enjoy on its own, but also pairs well with salads, fish, poultry and spicy dishes including fusion cuisine.
