



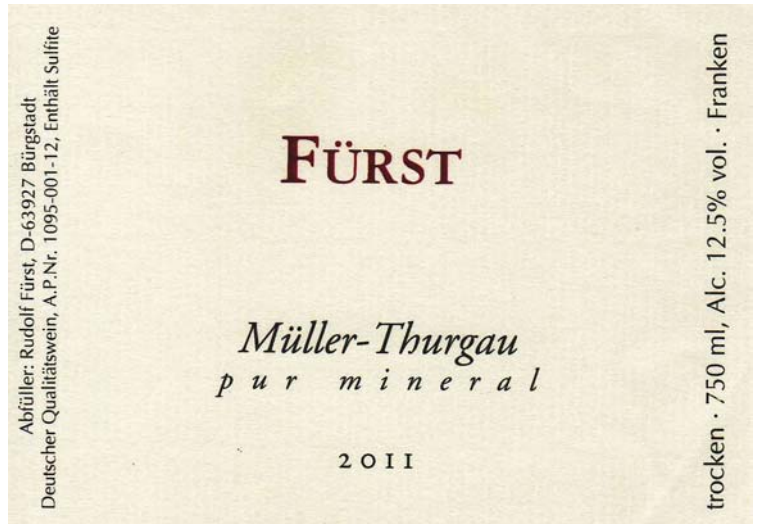

**Estate:** Paul Fürst was Gault-Millau winemaker of the Year in 2003. In addition to producing some of the finest white wines on the planet from Riesling, Pinot Blanc, Müller Thurgau and few others, Fürst belongs to the red wine elite in Germany for producing some of the most refined and finesseful Pinot Noirs in all of Germany. The vineyards are located in the villages of Bürgstadt with the Centgrafenberg and in Klingenberg with its Schlossberg.

**Tasting Note:** The floral and tropical nose is quite open and immediately brings you in. Lots of finesse on the palate, showing kiwi, pear cocktail and lemongrass; lots of fruit with a chalky mineral core, a fine pear skin texture and finely balanced acidity. Quite bright, fresh and lively.

**Food Affinity:** Fantastic to enjoy on its own, but also pairs well with fish dishes, sushi and light pastas.
