Estate: In 1890 Carl Gunderloch founded the estate by investing into the best vineyard sites of the “Rote Hang” area (“red slope area”) in the Rheinhessen appellation. Over the past decade, the 5th generation, Fritz and Agnes Hasselbach, have elevated the estate to world class earning 3 times, a perfect 100 point score, in the Wine Spectator for their TBA dessert wines from 1992, 1996 and 2001.

Tasting Note: The Gunderloch Spätlese shows poached peach, tangerine and lemon in the nose. White peach fruit with suggestions of mint and candied citrus zest are in the finish without being overly-sweet on the palate.

Food Affinity: Quite versatile; beautiful as aperitif or with light fair and great with fusion or far Eastern cuisine especially when containing some spiciness or sweetness.
