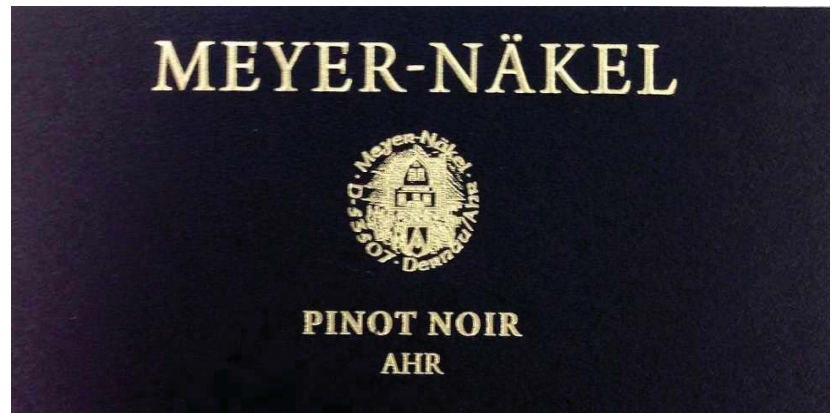

Estate: Five generations of the Meyer and Näkel families have cared for this winery in the Ahr, which was established by the Romans. These are the steepest vineyards in the world for Pinot Noir and 22 of the 37 acres of the Meyer-Näkel estate are Grosses Gewächs classed vineyards where the average annual yield is less than 50 hl/ha.

Tasting Note: In the glass, this Pinot Noir is a beautiful dark ruby color. The smokey dark cherry nose is very seductive. Once on the palate the dark cheery and cranberry fruit dance about the smoky slate minerality with notes of leather and coco all with a very fine and silky texture.

Food Affinity: Outstanding with grilled seafood, poultry as well as fine cuts of beef and game.
